Be Cautious Shopping Online

We've had several reports from customers who are surprised by recurring charges on their debit cards. Sometimes they've been shopping online and clicked a link they thought would let them safely purchase a product or order a free sample. After agreeing to some fine print and entering their debit card number customers may notice repeating or multiple charges.

After some investigation, customers may find they have unintentionally signed up for a recurring service or subscription. Here are some tips to help you avoid the frustration of unauthorized recurring charges:

Only shop at well-known, reputable websites – check online reviews or the Better Business Bureau.

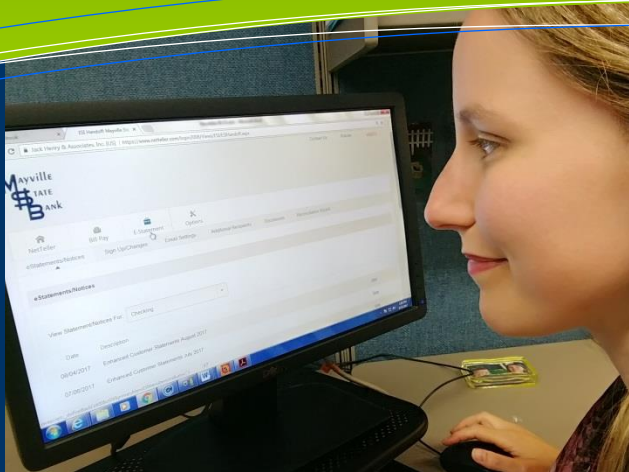
Recognize a subscription service – Sometimes a great deal is contingent on signing up for a subscription.

Do not give payment information for "free" items – if they have your card number they can charge your card.

Read the fine print – Know what you are agreeing to before you click.
